EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 13

AN ORDER APPOINTING AND DESIGNATING MRS. EDITHA P. PORMILOS AS HEAD OF THE OFFICE OF SENIOR CITIZENS AFFAIRS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, ILOILO.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the constitutional mandate of the state to provide priority for the needs of the underprivileged, sick, elderly, disabled, women and children, Republic Act 9994 otherwise known as the "Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010" was enacted further amending Republic Act No. 9257 known as the "Senior Citizens Act of 2003" amending Republic Act 7432 otherwise known as "An act to maximize the contribution of senior citizens to nation building, grand benefits and special privileges and for other purposes";

WHEREAS, section 6 of the Republic Act No. 9994 provides that there shall be established in all cities and municipalities an Office of the Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA) to be headed by a senior citizen who shall be appointed by the mayor for a term of three (3) years without reappointment but without prejudice to an extension if exigency so requires. The appointee shall be chosen from a list of three (3) nominees as recommended by a general assembly of senior citizens organizations in the city or municipality;

WHEREAS, the head of the OSCA shall be appointed to serve the interest of senior citizens and shall not be removed or replaced except for reasons of death, permanent disability or ineffective performance of his/her duties to the detriment of fellow senior citizens;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 444 (2) (iii) of R.A. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the Municipal Mayor may issue such Executive Orders as are necessary for the proper enforcement of laws and ordinances;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK P. PALABRICA, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Bingawan, Province of Iloilo, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby appoint and designate Mrs. Editha P. Pormilos as Head of the Office of Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA) of the Municipality effective April 29, 2018 upon expiration of the term of Mr. Eduardo B. Prior. As such, she shall perform the following duties and functions of the OSCA Head as stipulated in RA 9994, to wit:


- a.) To plan, implement and monitor yearly work programs in pursuance of the objectives of the Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010;
- b.) To draw up list of available and required services which can be provided by the Senior Citizens;

- c.) To maintain and regularly update on a quarterly basis the list of Senior Citizens and to issue national individual identification cards, free of charge, which shall be valid anywhere in the country;
- d.) To serve as a general information and liaison for Senior Citizens;
- e.) To monitor compliance of the provisions of the Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010 particularly the grant of special discounts and privileges to Senior Citizens;
- f.) To report to the Mayor, any individual, establishments, business entity, institutions or agency found violating any provision of this Act;
- g.) To assist the Senior Citizens in filing complaints or charges against any individual, establishment, business entity, institution, or agency refusing to comply with privileges under the Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010 before the Department of Justice (DOJ), the Provincial Prosecutor's Office, the Regional or the Municipal Trial Court, The Municipal Trial Court in Cities, or The Municipal Circuit Trial Court, and shall coordinate with the Office of the Mayor and Municipal Social Welfare Office.

Section 3. Effectivity. This Order shall take effect on April 29, 2018.
