MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 240
(Series of 2017)

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF PUBLIC TOILETS LOCATED AT THE PUBLIC MARKET BUILDING OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO.

WHEREAS, Section 154 of R. A. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 states that “the Local Government Units may fix the rates for the operation of public utilities owned, operated and maintained by them within their jurisdiction”;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bingawan, recognizing the increasing number of vendors, market goers, visitors and PUV passenger, is repairing/rehabilitating the Bingawan Public Market to improve the service facilities of the Public Toilets for public welfare;

WHEREAS, the market management have considered the basic service facility as additional source of revenues of the Municipality of Bingawan while providing job opportunity for the maintenance of sanitary condition of the said facilities;

WHEREAS, with the enactment of said Ordinance by the Sangguniang Bayan, prescribed fees and charges including the management rules and regulations pertinent shall be certainly expressed;

NOW THEREFORE:

ON MOTION of Hon. Leovy C. Simora, Floor Leader, duly seconded by Hon. Nemesio A. Cachite;

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Bingawan, Province of Iloilo, in a Regular Session assembled, that:

Section 1. Imposition of Fee. There shall be collected fees for the use of the municipal owned toilets located at the Public Market Compound of Bingawan, Iloilo. The following fees shall be as follows:

a. Urine - "Pangihi"	=	Php	5.00
b. Bowel Movement - "Pamus-on"	=		10.00
c. Bath - "Paligo"	=		10.00

Section 2. Time of Payment. The fee imposed herein shall be paid to the Municipal Treasurer or his/her authorized representative before using the Public Toilets.

Section 3. Administrative Provisions.

a. Management and Maintenance- The Public Toilets shall be operated and maintained by the assigned Utility Worker who is under the supervision of the Bingawan Public Market Office.

b. The assigned laborer shall maintain the sanitary condition of the Public Toilets at all times. They shall collect the necessary fees, through cash tickets which shall be remitted daily to the assigned Revenue Collector Clerk who is in custody of the key of the Public Toilets and shall maintain a separate ledger of incoming collections generated from the operation of Public Toilets.

d. All market stall and table lessee shall be exempt from payment of the said fee.

e. The Municipal Mayor shall issue such other rules and regulations for the smooth implementation of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Penalty. Any violation of the provision of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not less than One Thousand Pesos (P 1,000.00) but not more than Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00) or imprisonment of not less than one (1) month, but not more than six (6) months or both with such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

Section 5. Repealing Clause. This Ordinance repeals, modifies or amends any existing Ordinance inconsistent herewith.

Section 6. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect on the day following its posting in the bulletin board at the entrance of the Municipal Hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the municipality for a minimum period of three (3) consecutive weeks and after publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the Province of Iloilo.


