AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PALUPAD SA BINGAWAN AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF.

NOW THEREFORE:

On motion of Hon. Leovy C. Simora, duly seconded by Hon. Perceval T. Girao, Hon. Jofe C. Celeste and Hon. Nemesio A. Cachite;

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bingawan, Iloilo assembled that:

Section 1. Title. This ordinance shall be known and cited as the “Palupad sa Bingawan Ordinance of 2017.”

Section 2. Declaration of Policy. This ordinance shall be consistent with the National policy which declares tourism as an indispensable element of the National economy and an industry of national interest and importance which must be harnessed as an engine of socio-economic growth and cultural affirmation. The local government declares sustainable tourism as an essential means to fulfill economic and social need while maintaining cultural integrity, processes and life support. Relative thereto is the promotion

of social, economic and cultural well-being of the community involving capacities, resources, acceptance, empowerment and governance.

Section 3. Scope and Purpose. This ordinance shall only apply in the Municipality of Bingawan, Iloilo for the hereunder objectives, to wit:

- a. To create, establish and promote a summer flying event in Central Panay Island, envisioned of becoming a tourism event in the area;
- b. To attract both Local and National tourist to visit and explore Bingawan thereby boosting the economic activity and may provide opportunities to the locality; and
- c. It may promote the spirit of camaraderie and sportsmanship in the competing participants of the said event.

Section 4. Definition of Terms as used in this ordinance:

- a. Palupad- a local dialect which means “to fly” something;
- b. Kite Flying - an act or instance of flying a kite on a string and it needs sufficient wind in order to go up and fly. It requires good weather for this activity;
- c. Drone Flying - an activity where the drone (aerial robot) is remotely controlled or can fly autonomously through software-controlled flight plans;
- d. Extreme Bike Riding - is an activity where the biker is riding on a bike on or off the road with challenging obstacles;and
- e. Motocross - a closed-course motorcycle race over natural or simulated rough terrain (as with steep inclines, hairpin turns, and mud).

Section 5. Date and Venue . The Palupad sa Bingawan shall be conducted every 3rd week of April annually and shall be held in appropriate places in Bingawan, Iloilo.

Section 6. Categories of Event. There shall be the following events to be conducted during the Palupad sa Bingawan hereunder described to wit, but not limited to:

- a. Kite flying competition;
- b. Drone flying competition;
- c. Extreme bike riding competition; and
- d. Motocross competition

Section 7. Council. There shall be created a council to effectively implement this ordinance, to wit:

Chairperson- Municipal Mayor

Vice Chairperson- Municipal Vice Mayor

- Members
- Chairperson, on Committee on Tourism
 - Municipal Tourism Officer
 - Liga ng mga Barangay President
 - Sangguniang Kabataan federation President
 - Philippine National Police
 - Representative from Private Sector

-Representative from the Department of Education

Section 8. Administrative Provision. The Municipal Mayor may issue Executive Order for effective implementation of this ordinance.

Section 9. Funding. There shall be fund appropriated to be determined by the Palupad sa Bingawan Council every ensuing year purposely for the effective implementation of this ordinance. Further the local government may accept donations from private entities and corporations as sponsor of the said event.

Section 10. Repealing Clause. This Ordinance repeals, modifies or amends any existing Ordinance inconsistent herewith.

Section 11. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect on the day following its posting in the bulletin board at the entrance of the Municipal Hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the municipality for a minimum period of three (3) consecutive weeks.


