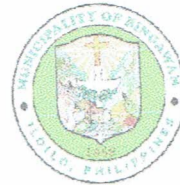

URGENT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING HON. MARK P. PALABRICA, MUNICIPAL MAYOR, MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, ILOILO TO ENTER AND SIGN FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, ILOILO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH CALINOG BUS LINE, A TRANSPORT COMPANY WITH BUSINESS ADDRESS AT BARANGAY CABAGIAO, CALINOG, ILOILO, HEREIN REPRESENTED BY MR. QUIRINO CELESTE, PROPRIETOR FOR EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE DURING DISASTERS/CALAMITIES.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit is mandated by law to extend assistance to victims of disasters;

WHEREAS, the LGU has a five percent (5%) Municipal Disasters Risk Reduction Management Fund, of the amount appropriated for MDRRMF, thirty percent (30%) shall be allocated as Quick Response Fund (QRF) for the relief and recovery programs in order that situation and living conditions of people in communities or areas stricken by disasters, calamities, epidemics, complex emergencies, may be normalized as quickly as possible;

WHEREAS, the Calinog Bus Line is a transport company that engaged in the business of ferrying passengers situated within the territorial jurisdiction of the LGU;

WHEREAS, the LGU cannot utilize their thirty percent (30%) MDRRM Fund before the occurrence of any disaster;

WHEREAS, by reason of limitations provided in the use of the said fund, the LGU recognizes the need to make arrangements with local transport to meet emergencies;

WHEREAS, Section 22 (c) of RA 7160 provides that "no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the Sanggunian concerned";
