URGENT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING HON. MARK P. PALABRICA, MUNICIPAL MAYOR, MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, ILOILO TO ENTER AND SIGN FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, ILOILO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH-REGIONAL OFFICE VI REPRESENTED BY MARLYN W. CONVOCAR, MD, MPH, CESO VI, FOR THE HEALTH FACILITY ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM (HFEP) 2017.

WHEREAS, one of the thrusts of the Duterte Administration is to achieve Universal Health Care for all Filipinos;

WHEREAS, the DOH issued Administrative Order No. 2016-0038 entitled "The Philippine Health Agenda 2016-2022" which seeks to fulfill the global call for Universal Health Coverage, adopting "All for Health towards Health for All" as the rallying point to realize the vision of a Healthy Philippines by 2022;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Health Agenda (PHA) aims to (1) ensure the best health outcomes for all, without socio-economic, ethnic, gender, and geographic disparities; (2) promote health and deliver healthcare through means and respect, value and empower clients and patients as they interact with the health system; and (3) protect all families especially the poor, marginalized, and vulnerable against the high cost of healthcare;

WHEREAS, the construction, expansion, repair/renovation and upgrading of health facilities of the DOH and Local Government Units (LGU) including the purchase of equipment is being appropriated in the General Appropriation Act of 2017 in alignment with Ambisyon Natin 2040 and the Philippine Development Plan 2017-2022;

WHEREAS, Department of Health thru the Health Facilities Enhancement Program for CY 2017 has appropriated the total amount of Five Million Pesos (Php 5,000,000.00) intended for the construction of Batangay Health Station to be implemented and procured by the Local Government Unit of Bingawan thru transfer of fund, to wit:

WHEREAS, Section 22 (c) of RA 7160 provides that "no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the Sanggunian concerned".

WHEREAS, in line thereto, the municipality needs to execute a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the referring party/s for specific guidelines on their respective responsibilities as regards to the acceptance of clients referred to the Balay Paglaum;

WHEREAS, Section 22 (c) of RA 7160 provides that "no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the Sanggunian concerned".


