URGENT RESOLUTION OF CONDOLENCE TO THE BEREAVED PLAGATA FAMILY AND THE APPRECIATION OF THE LEGACY LEFT BEHIND BY THE LATE DR. ERWIN JALBUENA PLAGATA.

WHEREAS, the late Dr. Erwin J. Plagata started his public service career as Rural Health Physician of the Municipality of Bingawan, Province of Iloilo, from January 19, 1983 to February 29, 1984;

WHEREAS, his sterling qualities – honesty, sincerity and dedication to public service – made him decide to run for elective post in the City of Iloilo, as Sangguniang Panglunsod Member which he won and thus served from July 1, 1995 to June 30, 1998; and from July 1, 2001 to June 30, 2010;

WHEREAS, true to his vision and true to his call and even truer to the title given to him, he became a real servant to the public, not one who makes a servant out of the public; for the late Dr. Erwin J. Plagata was truthful in words and fruitful in deeds – a man so eloquent that even his life can speak;

Plagata will forever be remembered not only by the people of the City of Iloilo, but also by the people of Bingawan, not only of this generation but of the generations to come;


