AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE DUNGGANON NGA BINGAWANON AWARD IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the Dunganon Nga Bingawanon Award is a recognition of the success stories of Bingawanon in different fields and as a special feature of the Municipal Foundation Day Celebration;

WHEREAS, establishment of the Dunganon Nga Bingawanon Award through a local legislation will assure its continuity and permanence;

WHEREAS, it needs to define the parameters of the selection process to avoid personal feelings, closeness or bias from interfering in the choice considering the prestige of the Award given to the truly deserving.

Section 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as **AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE DUNGGANON NGA BINGAWANON AWARD IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR.**

Section 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For the purpose of this Ordinance the following shall be construed to mean:



Civic - relating to a Municipality, its citizens.

Dungganon Nga Bingawanon Award - is the highest award given to Bingawanon.

Exemplary- worthy to be copied, typical, serving as an example or illustration.

Impact- the impression made by a person, thing or idea, imparting force or effect that is beneficial or necessary.

Section 3. THE DUNGGANON NGA BINGAWANON AWARD COMMITTEE. The Dunganon nga Bingawanon Award Committee shall be composed of the following:

- a) Municipal Mayor as Chairperson;
- b) Municipal Vice Mayor as Vice Chairperson;
- c) Municipal Tourism Officer as Secretary;
- d) Members:
 - SB Member, Chairperson of Committee on Education, Culture, History and Tourism;
 - CSO Representative;
 - District Supervisor of the Department of Education assigned in Bingawan;
 - Two (2) religious sector representatives;
 - Liga ng mga Barangay President;
 - SK Municipal Federation President; and
 - MLGOO.

Section 4. FUNCTIONS OF THE ANG DUNGGANON NGA BINGAWANON AWARD COMMITTEE. The Committee shall prepare its own rules and regulations and qualifications of nominees for the award. They shall meet at least once a month or at the call of the Chairperson as the need arises.

The duty of the Dungganon nga Bingawanon Award Committee is to draw up a list of prospective members of the Board of Judges preferably prominent and respected residents of the Municipality and to choose not less than five (5) nor more than seven (7) to compose the Board of Judges.

The Committee shall also undertake all the preparations and activities relative to the Dungganon nga Bingawanon Award including but not limited to the setting or extension of deadline for the submission of nomination forms with its supporting documents, procurement and design of medals, trophies and plaques of appreciations as the case maybe.

The Committee shall initiate extensive information dissemination, among others, to all barangays, churches, schools and other civic/people organizations regarding the search for the Dungganon nga Bingawanon Award.

Section 5. THE BOARD OF JUDGES. The Board of Judges once chosen and composed shall function independently with the Committee on selection of the awardee(s).

They shall choose from among themselves in a meeting called for the purpose, a chairperson. It shall evaluate the nominees submitted based on the criteria set forth and select awardees by a vote of simple majority.

Section 6. AWARDING DAY. The awarding day shall be on the occasion of the Bingawan Foundation Day on the 21st day of June each year that is distinct and separate from all other awarding ceremonies of the Municipality.

Section 7. FUNDING. The municipality shall appropriate an annual budget of at least FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (Php 50,000.00) as initial fund to be taken from the General Fund of the annual budget of the municipality and shall be augmented /supplemented as the need arises.

Section 8. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS. The Municipal Mayor shall issue such other rules and regulations for the smooth implementation of this Ordinance.

Section 9. EFFECTIVITY. - This Ordinance shall take effect on the day following its posting in the bulletin board at the entrance of the Municipal Hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the municipality for a minimum period of three (3) consecutive weeks.




