AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO.2005-01 PRESCRIBING FEES FOR RENTAL OF GYMNASIUM OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO.

Section 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the “Bingawan Gymnasium Utilization Ordinance”.

Section 2. Fees. It is hereby prescribed the following fees and charges for the use of the Bingawan Gymnasium including its facilities and equipment by private individuals, companies or groups, as follows:

Without use of electric power	Php	100.00 per hour
With use of electric fan only		200.00 per hour
with use of light lamp only		200.00 per hour
With use of public address system only		300.00 per hour
With use of light lamps and electric fan		300.00 per hour
With use of electric fan and public address system/		400.00 per hour
With use of light lamps, electric fan, public address system and other equipment		500.00 per hour
Using equipment owned by the municipality,		1,000.00 per hour

Section 3. Payment of Fees and Charges. Collection of fees and charges shall be paid directly to the Office of the Municipal Treasurer before the issuance of Mayor's Permit.

Section 4. Regulated Acts. Private individuals, companies or groups renting the Bingawan Gymnasium shall:

- a) maintain cleanliness within the surrounding and facilities of the Gymnasium;
- b) minimize the volume of their sound system starting at 9:00 o'clock in the evening that would not disturb the surrounding inhabitants;
- c) during special occasions such as weddings, birthdays and other special functions, minors are not allowed to join/engage in drinking alcoholic beverages;
- d) smoking is not allowed at all times; and
- e) in case of damages during the use of the Gymnasium, its facilities and equipment, the individual, company or group hosting the event shall be held liable.

Section 5. Exemptions. Activities which are actually, directly and exclusively used for religious, educational, charitable and cooperative purposes and activities of the Local Government Unit of Bingawan including those of the barangay shall be exempted from this ordinance provided a duly approved Mayor's Permit is secured.

Section 6. Trust Fund. All fees and charges derived from the Bingawan Gymnasium shall be deposited by the Municipal Treasurer in a Trust Fund which is hereby created to cover the maintenance and operating expenses of the said facility.

Section 7. Penalty. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance, or of the rules and regulations promulgated under authority of this Ordinance, shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 2,500.00), or imprisonment of not exceeding six (6) months or both such fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the Court.

Section 8. Administrative Provision. The Municipal Mayor shall issue such other rules and regulations for the smooth implementation of this Ordinance.

Section 9. Separability Clause. If for any reason, any provision, section or part of this Ordinance is declared not valid by a Court or competent jurisdiction or suspended or revoked by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, such judgement shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, section or parts thereof which shall remain or continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 10. Applicability Clause. All other matters relating to the impositions in this Ordinance shall be governed by pertinent provision of existing laws and other ordinances.

Section 11. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, rules and regulations, or parts thereof, in conflict with, or inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.





ENACTED, this 28th day of March 2018.


