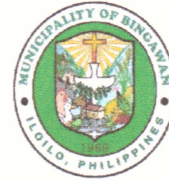

**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 224  
(Series of 2016)**

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE PEOPLE'S LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARD IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO.**

**ON MOTION** of Hon. Leovy C. Simora, duly seconded by Hon. Perceval T. Girao;

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Sangguniang Bayan assembled that:

**Section 1.** This ordinance shall be known as the "*People's Law Enforcement Ordinance of 2016*".

**Section 2.** Declaration of Policy. It is a declared policy of the local government unit of Bingawan to strengthen the People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB) having given jurisdiction to hear and decide citizen's complaints or cases filed before it against erring officers and members of the Philippine National Police (PNP) assigned in the locality, in deference to R.A. 8551, otherwise known as the "*Philippine National Police Reform Act of 1998*" and R.A. 6975, otherwise known as the "*Department of the Interior and Local Government Act of 1990*", as amended.

**Section 3.** Creation and Functions. There is hereby created a People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB) in the Municipality of Bingawan, Province of Iloilo. It shall be the central receiving entity for any citizen's complaint against the officers and members of the PNP and shall have jurisdiction to hear and decide cases filed before it.

**Section 4.** Composition and Term of Office. The PLEB shall be composed of the following:

1. one (1) Sangguniang Bayan member chosen from among themselves;
2. one (1) Punong Barangay chosen from among themselves; and
3. three (3) other members to be chosen by the Peace and Order Council:
  - a. must be a woman;
  - b. college graduate/member of the bar; and
  - c. central elementary school principal.

The chairman of the PLEB shall be elected from among its members. The term of office of the members of the PLEB shall be for a period of three years from the assumption of office. Such members shall hold office until their successors shall have been chosen and qualified.

**Section 5.** Compensation and Benefits. The PLEB members shall be paid per diem and shall be provided with life insurance as may be determined by the sanggunian from the municipal fund.

**Section 6.** Budget Allocation. There shall be an allocation to be incorporated in the annual budget of the local government purposely for the maintenance and operation of the PLEB.

**Section 7.** Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect after its approval and posting in two conspicuous places in the Municipal Hall.


