RESOLUTION REQUESTING PRESIDENT RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES, THROUGH THE CONGRESS OF THE PHILIPPINES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS FOR THE CONVERSION OF A BARANGAY ROAD IN BARANGAY SWITCH, TAPAZ, CAPIZ INTO A NATIONAL ROAD LINKING TWO NATIONAL ROADS, NAMELY: BAJE - NGINGI-AN - BINGAWAN ROAD IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO AND OLD ILOILO - CAPIZ ROAD IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAPAZ, PROVINCE OF CAPIZ.

WHEREAS, the barangay road in Barangay Switch, Tapaz, Capiz has a length of 500 linear meters that connects two national roads of two municipalities and two provinces namely: Baje - Ngingi-an - Bingawan Road in the Municipality of Bingawan, Province of Iloilo and Old Iloilo - Capiz Road in the Municipality of Tapaz, Province of Capiz;

WHEREAS, Vice Mayor Matt P. Palabrica, Ph.D. rendered a privilege speech expressing and presenting the status of the said barangay road, its impact to local and national economy and contribution to peace, order and security;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Tapaz, Capiz is a first income class municipality with a population of 51,313 (2015 census) and the Municipality of Bingawan, Iloilo is a fifth income class municipality with 15,199 people (2015 census);

WHEREAS, because the said barangay road is an earth road and links two national highways, it is hard for the barangay and municipal governments to maintain and improve it brought about by great volume of vehicles and commuters passing through;

NOW THEREFORE:

On motion of Hon. Ted Peter P. Plagata, duly seconded by Hon. Nemesio A. Cachite;

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, request President Rodrigo Roa Duterte of the Republic of the Philippines, through the Congress of the Philippines and the Department of Public Works and Highways for the Conversion of a Barangay Road in Barangay Switch, Tapaz, Capiz into a National Road inking two national roads, namely: Baje – Ngingi-an – Bingawan road in the Municipality of Bingawan, Province of Iloilo and old Iloilo – Capiz Road in the Municipality of Tapaz, Province of Capiz.

RESOLVED FURTHER, urging the Municipality of Tapaz, Capiz to support and pass the same resolution;

Lonylon Faldas - Punong Barangay, Brgy. Poblacion, Bingawan, Iloilo and Hon. Regina Fancubila – Punong Barangay, Brgy. Switch, Tapaz, Capiz for support, information and favorable action.
