EJERCITO, SENATOR, REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES, THE AMOUNT OF FIVE MILLION PESOS (PHP 5,000,000.00) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ADDITIONAL CLASSROOM BUILDING AT BINGAWAN CENTRAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, BARANGAY POBLACION, BINGAWAN, ILOILO.**

**WHEREAS**, Bingawan Central Elementary School is the only Central School in the Municipality;

**WHEREAS**, as a town that was hardly hit by Super Typhoon Yolanda last 2013, the building that houses the industrial classroom was totally destroyed and cannot be utilized by the school anymore;

**WHEREAS**, aside from the destroyed industrial classroom, the Marcos Building that was built during the time of President Ferdinand Marcos and is still being used until now need to be condemned due to its unsafe and dilapidated state and its continuous use will further expose the pupils to certain injuries;

**WHEREAS**, as a Central Elementary School, it always wanted to provide its student a well rounded education by offering them a diverse curriculum in a variety of academic fields along with providing students with numerous extra-curricular opportunities;

**WHEREAS**, this mission of providing a wholistic education is always hindered by the lack of classrooms to accommodate the pupils and school's resources;

**WHEREAS**, as a fifth class Municipality in the Province of Iloilo, it will be very hard for the LGU to come up with a budget to build additional classrooms;


**WHEREAS**, the municipality is asking for financial assistance from your good office for the construction of the said infrastructure project;

**NOW THEREFORE:**


**On motion of** Hon. Ted Peter P. Plagata, Deputy Floor Leader, duly seconded by Hon. Perceval T. Girao;
