**Resolution No. 44 - 2016**

**URGENT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING HON. MARK P. PALABRICA, MUNICIPAL MAYOR, MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, ILOILO TO ENTER AND SIGN FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, ILOILO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE ILOILO PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT (IPG) REPRESENTED BY ITS PROVINCIAL GOVERNOR HON. ARTHUR D. DEFENSOR, SR. FOR THE USE OF THE ILOILO PROVINCIAL DEVELOPMENT CENTER FOR WOMEN AND CHILDREN (IPDCWC).**

**WHEREAS**, R.A. 7610, otherwise known as the “Special Protection of Children, Abuse, Exploitation and Discrimination Act” states that it shall be the policy of the state to provide special protection to children from all forms of abuse, neglect, cruelty, exploitation and discrimination and other conditions prejudicial to their development;

**WHEREAS**, the Iloilo Provincial Development Center for Women and Children (IPDCWC) a crisis center under the Iloilo Provincial Government and was established to resolved the cases on Violence against Women and Children (VAWC) and other behavioral patterns problems to serve, assist and protect individuals and families, women and children in crisis situation in ways that strengthen their coping capacity and encourage personal responsibility to prevent them from further exposure to calamity, exploitation, abuse, neglect and displacement, and to enable them to restore their normal functioning towards family reunification and community reintegration;

**WHEREAS**, the same also serves as temporary shelter and restorative services to children and women for placement setting, referral and for other rehabilitative related services;

**WHEREAS**, IPDCWC is not only a house of refuge to women and children but also an environment that gives hope to its residents in rebuilding their self-esteem and self-respect towards new life;

**WHEREAS**, the same is already operational and ready to accept clients coming from municipalities within the Province as temporary shelter for not more than seven (7) days to two (2) weeks as specified in the Manual of Operation unless otherwise the clients recommended by the Local Social Welfare and Development Officer and the Center Head to stay longer;

**WHEREAS**, Sec. 22 (d) of R.A. 7160 provides that “no contract maybe entered by the Local Chief Executive in behalf of the LGU without prior authorization by the Sanggunian concerned”.

**NOW THEREFORE:**

**ON MOTION** of Hon. Joy L. Quimba, duly seconded by Hon. Nemesio A. Cachite and Hon. Leovy C. Simora;


