**Resolution No. 51 – 2017**

**RESOLUTION STRONGLY REQUESTING DONATION OF CONFISCATED LOGS FROM THE COMMUNITY ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICE (CENRO), THROUGH: MA. ALMA D. MONTANO, OIC CENRO, BAROTAC NUEVO, ILOILO.**

**WHEREAS**, the 61<sup>st</sup> Infantry Battalion of the Philippine Army confiscated undocumented logs and lumber at Barangay Inamyungan, Bingawan, Iloilo, last July 25, 2016, and said items are stored at the 61<sup>st</sup> IB Headquarters in Tapaz, Capiz;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 2 (b) of **Memorandum Order No. 162, Series of 1993**, "Providing Guidelines for the Disposition of Confiscated Logs, Lumber and Other Forest Products for Public Infrastructure Projects and Other Purposes", the Municipal Governments are qualified to receive donations of confiscated logs, lumber and other forest products;

**WHEREAS**, considering the fact that the undocumented logs were confiscated from the component Barangay of the Municipality of Bingawan, it is but fitting that it should be given top priority consideration as donee/recipient of said logs, as per Section 4 thereof as amended by Memorandum Order No. 285, Series of 1995;

**WHEREAS**, the local government unit of Bingawan is in dire need of 12,818 board feet of logs to rehabilitate its Municipal Agriculture Office and Motor Pool which were heavily damaged by Super Typhoon Yolanda last November 8, 2013;

**NOW THEREFORE:**


