AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4, SERIES OF 1999 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL OPERATORS OF MOBILE RICE/CORN MILLS OPERATING WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, ILOILO TO USE SACKS OR ANY RECEPTACLE TO COLLECT RICE/CORN HUSKS AND ANY WASTE PRODUCTS FOR PROPER DISPOSAL.

Section 1. Title. Municipal Ordinance No. 4, Series of 1999 shall be amended to read, **"An Ordinance Requiring All Operators of Mobile Rice/Corn Mills Operating Within the Municipality of Bingawan, Iloilo to Use Sacks or Any Receptacle to Collect Rice/Corn Husks and Any Waste Products for Proper Disposal"**.

Section 2. Legal Basis. This Ordinance shall be governed by the provisions of the PD 856 or the Sanitation Code of the Philippines; RA 9003 or the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act; RA 8749 or the Clean Air Act; Republic Act No. 4136 or the Land

Transportation and Traffic Code; RA 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991; and their Implementing Rules and Regulations.

Section 3. Regulated Act. No operator of mobile rice/corn mills operating within the Municipality of Bingawan, Province of Iloilo shall mill rice, corn or other cereals, or for any similar purposes provided the operator shall use sacks or any receptacle to collect rice/corn husks and any waste products for proper disposal.

Proper disposition of rice/corn husks and other waste materials shall be borne by the owner of rice/corn milled/shelled.

Section 4. Venue for Milling Operation. A designated area shall be identified in every barangay by the Barangay Councils for the milling operation of rice, corn or other cereals or for any similar purposes.

Section 5. Administrative Provision. The Municipal Mayor may issue such other rules or regulations for the proper implementation of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Enforcement. The members of the Bingawan Municipal Police Station, Punong Barangay, Kagawads of the Sangguniang Barangay and the duly appointed Barangay Tanods are hereby authorized to apprehend any milling operators who violate this Ordinance.

Section 7. Penalty Clause. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be fine by not more than P 2,500.00 or imprisoned not more than 6 months, or both at the discretion of the court.

Section 8. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, resolutions and regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified, accordingly.

Section 9. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect on the day following its posting in the bulletin board at the entrance of the Municipal Hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the municipality for a minimum period of three (3) consecutive weeks and after publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the Province of Iloilo.


