



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 05

"AN ORDER PROVIDING FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF MIDWIVES TO DIFFERENT BARANGAY HEALTH STATIONS AND HEALTH CENTERS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, ILOILO"

WHEREAS, it is a declared policy of the Local Government Unit of Bingawan to promote effective and efficient delivery of health services to its constituency;

WHEREAS, the assignment of Midwives to Barangay Health Stations and Health Centers would monitor pregnant patients through prenatal and postnatal services and immunization of children, adolescents, and senior citizens in accordance with policies set forth by the Department of Health;

NOW THEREFORE, I MARK P. PALABRICA, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Bingawan, Iloilo by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby provide for the assignment of midwives to different Barangay Health Stations and Health Centers in the Municipality of Bingawan, Iloilo and hereby order the following:

Section 1: Assignment of Midwives:

Section 2. Duties and Responsibilities

1. Deliver babies at Bingawan Birthing Center and answer delivery call at all times;
2. To do Postnatal visits to newly-delivered mothers and babies rendering nursing care;
3. To do Postnatal follow up to newly-delivered mothers attended by skilled health personnel;
4. Help educate pregnant mothers by encouraging them to visit their respective health stations regularly for prenatal check-up including all cases of sickness of children;
5. Assist doctor's consultation and clinic;
6. Conduct Integrated Management of Childhood Illness (IMCI);
7. Provide Family Planning counselling and services;
8. Give regular immunization to preschool children and to children of all ages in cases of epidemic;

9. Refer patients to the hospital if necessary;
10. Maintain good relations to the community;
11. Comply with all health related policies of the Department of Health;
12. Attend monthly conference and submit monthly and quarterly reports and other necessary requirements as required by the Public Health Nurse for approval by the LCE;

Section 3. Effectivity – This order shall take effect immediately.
