**AN ORDER REORGANIZING THE MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN.**

**WHEREAS**, the increasing volume of garbage, if not properly manage, is a serious threat to the general welfare and health of the people, as well as, to the integrity of the environment;

**WHEREAS**, health and environment problem of the community requires utmost attention and cooperation among the concerned national government agencies, local government units, business community, civil society organization, and the people in general;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Republic Act No. 9003 known as Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 and Municipal Ordinance No. 7-2009 otherwise known as "No Segregation, No Collection Policy" and to effectively implement plans and programs, the Local Government Unit is hereby mandated to organize the Solid Waste Management Board at its own local level;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I MARK P. PALABRICA**, Municipal Mayor for the Municipality of Bingawan, Province of Iloilo, by virtue of powers vested in me by law, do hereby reorganized the Municipal Solid Waste Management Board, to wit:

**Section 2: FUNCTIONS.**


The Municipal Solid Waste Management Board shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. Develop a Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan to ensure long term solid waste management, as well as, integrate the various solid waste management plans and strategies of barangays;
- b. Adopt measures to promote and ensure the viability and effective implementation of solid waste management programs in all barangays;
- c. Monitor the implementation of the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan through the barangays and in cooperation with concerned non-government organizations;
- d. Adopt specific revenue-generating measures to promote the viability of the Solid Waste Management Plans;
- e. Convene regular meetings for purposes of planning and coordinating the implementation of the Solid Waste Management Plans of barangays;
- f. Oversee the implementation of the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan;
- g. Review every two (2) years or as the need arises the Municipal Waste Management Plan for purposes of ensuring its sustainability, viability, effectiveness, and relevance in relation to local and international development in the field of solid waste management;
- h. Develop specific mechanism and guidance to implement the Municipal Solid Waste and Management Plan;
- i. Recommend to appropriate local government authorities specific measures or proposals for franchise of built-operate transfer agreement with duly recognized institutions to provide either exclusive or non-exclusive authority for the collection, transfer, storage, processing, recycling or disposal of municipal solid waste;
- j. Provide the necessary logistical and operational support to component barangays;
- k. Recommend measures and safeguards against pollution and the preservation of the natural ecosystem;
- l. Coordinate the effort of component barangays in the implementation of the Municipal Waste Management Plan, and;
- m. Call on any concern agency or sector, as it may deem necessary, for support or other appropriate action.

**Section 3: EFFECTIVITY**

This order shall take effect immediately.
