Resolution No. 46 – 2018

URGENT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING HON. MARK P. PALABRICA, MUNICIPAL MAYOR, MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, ILOILO TO ENTER AND SIGN FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BINGAWAN, ILOILO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG) REPRESENTED HEREIN BY ITS REGIONAL DIRECTOR, ATTY. ANTHONY C. NUYDA, CESO III, THE NATIONAL YOUTH COMMISSION (NYC) REPRESENTED HEREIN BY ITS OIC CHAIRPERSON AND CEO, ASEC. RONALD GIAN CARLO CARDEMA, THE LIGA NG MGA BARANGAY (LNB) REGION 6 REPRESENTED HEREIN BY LNB REGION 6 PRESIDENT, DINDO JOHN D. LIGNIG, AND WEST VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY (WVSU) REPRESENTED BY ITS PRESIDENT, DR. LUIS M. SOROLLA, JR. FOR THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN (SK) MANDATORY TRAINING.

WHEREAS, the approval of the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Reform Act of 2015 or RA 10742 on January 15, 2016 gave way to strengthen and empower the SK and transform it into a useful conduit for youth involvement in community development. Its passage reflects the vote of the Filipino youth's ability to lead and participate in the country's development;

WHEREAS, the Implementing Rules and Regulations, Rule V, Section 30 of the Act states that, " For the purpose of emphasizing the role of the youth in nation-building and molding them to become better citizens with values of patriotism, nationalism and honor as a Filipino, any SK official, whether elected or appointed, or any member of the LYDC must undergo the mandatory training program before she or he can assume office";

WHEREAS, the law mandated (Sec.31 of RA 10742) the National Youth Commission and the DILG with the assistance of the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP), Local Government Academy (LGA) University of the Philippines-National College of Public Administration and Governance (UP-NCPAG) and in consultation with youth stakeholders to jointly design and implement the mandatory and continuing training programs;

WHEREAS, considering the magnitude of the task for the mandatory training, the DILG through the Local Government Academy spearheaded the development and conduct of Orientation and Workshop for Service Providers on the conduct of SK Mandatory Training;

WHEREAS, the said activity is a complementary track to reinforce the conduct of the SK Mandatory Training Program by the Local Governance Regional Resource Centers (LGRRCs). Local academic institutions as part of the Multi-Stakeholdership Advisory Council of the LGRRCs will be tapped to ensure a sustained effort in implementing the mandatory training;

WHEREAS, the LGU having the jurisdiction and is directly engaged with the SK through various mechanisms based on the provisions in the SK Reform Act;

WHEREAS, the LRI as training institution known for having expertise and is committed to providing high quality training and learning are believed to be capable in managing and facilitating the conduct of the SK Mandatory Training in their regions.

WHEREAS, Section 22 (c) of RA 7160 provides that “no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the Sanggunian concerned”.

NOW THEREFORE:

On motion of Hon. Leovy C. Simora, Floor Leader, duly seconded by Hon. Nemesio A. Cachite;

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to authorize Hon. Mark P. Palabrica, Municipal Mayor, Municipality of Bingawan, Iloilo to enter and sign for and in behalf of the Municipality of Bingawan, Iloilo a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) represented herein by its Regional Director, Atty. Anthony C. Nuyda, CESO III, the National Youth Commission (NYC) represented herein by its OIC Chairperson and CEO, Asec. Ronald Gian Carlo Cardema, the Liga ng mga Barangay (LnB) Region 6 represented herein by Lnb Region 6 President, Dindo John D. Lignig, and West Visayas State University (WVSU) represented by its president, Dr. Luis M. Sorolla, Jr. for the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Mandatory Training.
