Resolution No. 82 – 2018

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CONVERSION OF BULABOG ELEMENTARY SCHOOL INTO FRANCISCO DEMORITO CARBON INTEGRATED SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, Article 23 of R. A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that “ xxx no names of public places xxx shall be changed unless by unanimous vote of the sanggunian and in consultation with the National Historical Institute (NHI)”;

WHEREAS, pursuant further to Art. 23 (par c 4), “a change of name of a local public school shall be made only upon the recommendation of the Local School Board;

WHEREAS, as per Section 17 of the Republic Act No. 7160 or otherwise known as the Local government Code of 1991, the local government units shall provide basic education services and facilities which includes school building and other facilities for public elementary and secondary schools;

WHEREAS, one of the requirements set forth by the DepEd Order No. 40 Series 2014 is the resolution from the Sangguniang Bayan supporting the conversion of school into an integrated school;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bingawan being a remote and plateau area classified as fifth-class municipality, has only two national high schools (Bingawan National High School and Jovita Alfaras Rivera National High School) which are 7-11 kilometers away from its area of influence/coverage;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan supports the conversion of Bulabog Elementary School into Francisco Demorito Carbon Integrated School because through its conversion, learners from barangays Bulabog, Cairohan and Tubod Bingawan, Iloilo will be catered and be given quality and holistic education;

WHEREAS, should this conversion be approved, learners shall be spared from walking 7-11 kilometers trek just to attend school;

WHEREAS, the conversion will really helped the learners in achieving their dreams and ambitions and will uplift the living status of their families;

NOW THEREFORE:

ON MOTION of Hon. Eduardo A. Dalipe, duly seconded by Hon. Nemesio A. Cachite;

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to support the conversion of Bulabog Elementary School into Francisco Demorito Carbon Integrated School;
